This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections for Bal Vatika is restricted to 03 (01 each for Bal Vatika I,II & III respectively). Further, the total number of sections for classes 1st to 12th shall be restricted to 16 only out of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary level classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension.
2	School has separate and functional website but has no direct link for Mandatory Disclosure Link for access of general information to the public. School should have direct MPD link with all renewed public documents uploaded thereon in compliance of circular no 09/2021. The compliance should be made and uploaded on SAAS portal within 03 months.
3	School has not affixed the side railings on either side of the ramp at the school entrance which is not safe for wheelchair bound person. School should follow the circular no 05/2023 and make all suitable arrangement and required infrastructure keep the ramp with all facilities as per guidelines. The compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months with YouTube video link.
4	The composite science lab need to be further upgraded as per SoPs and Board guidelines notified vide circular no 11/2022. The work stations for chemistry and biology sections are arranged on wooden surface tables which are not safe. Further, the safe and locked storage for chemicals and instruments is also not properly arranged. School is directed to follow the SoPs and arrange the lab with safety measures and adequate seating arrangements. The compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
5	The work stations in Biology and Composite science lab seems to be of wooden surface which are not safe due to heating facility and availability of inflammable chemicals. School should have works stations with fire resist surface and arrange the labs with all safety arrangements as per SoPs and Board guidelines as notified vide circular no 11/2022. The compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
6	School should arrange for proper safety gas fitting for heating facility in chemistry lab. The LPG cylinder is placed in open near the window is temporary arrangement and not safe. Further, the labs have no safety grills in window also. School should make proper safety arrangements for safe gas connection and keep the cylinder under lock away from labs. The compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months.
7	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, CBSE, Ajmer and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
