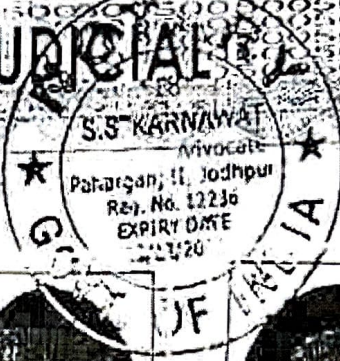

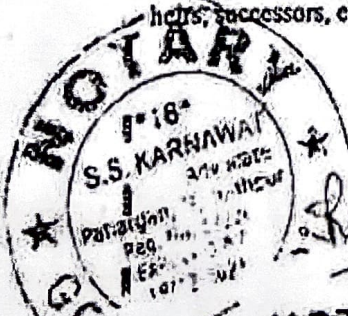

AMENDMENT IN DEED OF DECLARATION OF PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST

This deed of declaration of a public charitable trust is made on this 21st day of September 2017 between the "settlers" of the trust namely:

1. Smt Dr Sheetal Atul Singh W/O Atul sankhla age 37 magra punjla Jodhpur and
2. Smt Ritika Bohra w/o vishal bohra age 37 . 15 bohra sadan dawarka puri c-scheme , Jaipur (the expression "settlers of the trust" shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, include their heirs, successors, executors, administrators, assigns and other similar person.)

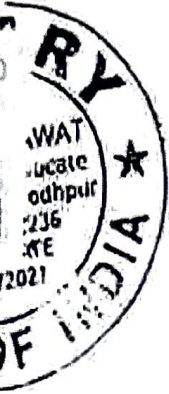
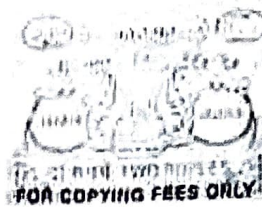

The "trustees of the trust namely :

1. Smt Ritika Bohra w/o Vishal Bohra age 37, 15 Bohra Sadan Dawarka Puri c- scheme, Jaipur
2. Shri Atul Sankhla son of Shri Sanwal Singh Sankhla, aged about 37 years, residing at Magra Punjola, Jodhpur.
3. Smt Dr Sheetal Atul Singh W/O Atul Sankhla age 37 Magra Punjola Jodhpur and
4. Vishal Bohra s/o Bhim Raj Bohra, age 40 years, 15 Bohra Sadan Dawarka Puri c- scheme, Jaipur (the expression "trustee of the trust" shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context include their heirs, successors, executors, administrators, assigns and other similar persons.)

Whereas the settlers are desirous of creating a public charitable trust under the NAME **RAJASTHAN EDUCATIONAL WELFARE TRUST**, for various charitable purposes which have being stated hereinafter and for that purpose they are irrevocable settling an amount of Rs. 100/- each in cash on the trustees to hold the same upon the trust and to utilize the same the purpose of the trust.

The Constitution of the Trust shall be as under :

1. **NAME** : The name of the public charitable trust shall be **RAJASTHAN EDUCATIONAL WELFARE TRUST**

OFFICE : The principal office of the trust shall be at Magra Punjola, Char Thamba, Jodhpur which can be changed by the trustees as per need.

JURISDICTION : The jurisdiction of the trust shall be throughout India and abroad however any legal action or disputes would be settled in the court of law at Jodhpur.

OBJECTS : A foresaid trust has been evolved to fulfill following aims and objects.

i. To setup, run and administrator educational institution/s /Schools for advancement under propagation of education, knowledge, research and development.

ii. To provide medical relief to public through any of the possible manners like rendering medical aid, running hospitals, dispensaries, clinics, diagnostic centers, Pharmaceutical laboratories, running, managing testing centers, school/s and/or college/s for teaching subjects/s relating to medical sciences and/or imparting training relating to medical relief.

iii. To establish and maintain institution/s for educational advancement and to promote education in any other appropriate number.

iv. To provide relief to poor and to help and serve people in need of medical attention, in every possible/feasible way through the set-up of the trust.

To advance any other object/s of general public utility like production, promotion, distribution and sale of herbal and ayurvedic plants and medicine through chain of medical stores, establishment and/or maintenance of sanatorium for recuperation and treatment of chronic disease, correction centre and rehabilitation centre for spreading awareness and service to free people from any addiction, and also running "Vaidshalla", " dharmshallas", rest house, old age house, orphanage and crèche, house for handicapped and widow, to extend a helping hand to the needy, neglected and unfortunate sectors of the society.

vi.

To acquire, construct, improve and maintain buildings for purpose of conducting school/s, college/s, lectures, libraries, laboratories, seminars, conference, courses, hospitals, etc for attaining/achieving any one or more of the aforesaid objects.

vii.

To impart/spread elementary, secondary, higher, technical, paramedical, dental, medical education or any kind of education and / or knowledge to the masses.

To establish and run school/s, college/s, universities, and other educational and training institutions.

To establish and run medical college/Dental colleges/Homoeopathy medical college/pharmacy colleges and or physiotherapy, Ayurvedic college/Unani naturpathy etc. any other system of medicine, Engineering College, Schools for Information Technology, school and or colleges for Business Management, Law colleges, Aviation, Marine engineering etc., Nursing school and colleges, Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Polytechnic colleges and other graduate, post graduates, research and diploma institutes and also hospital and other required institutions, which will be established for the sole purpose of providing a training ground for these educational institute.

To arrange for lectures, courses, conference, seminars for dissemination of educational information among groups of students, teachers or general public.

Where the running of any educational institutions of the trust requires establishment of a hospital, nursing home, botanical garden, etc. solely for the purpose of providing training for students of medicines, then such ancillary institutions may be established and run.

To construct wells, drinking water rooms, park and gardens, toilets, etc for use of common man. In times of need, also help the Government or any other organization to fight natural calamities like flood, drought, earthquake, fire, epidemic, etc and provide service to mankind.

To invite and honor scholars, educationalists, intellectuals, etc. and erect statues or monuments in their memory solely with a view to spread their message relating to education among masses.

To conduct research on matters pertaining to science, technology, sociology, theology and philosophy and to publish the results of such research.

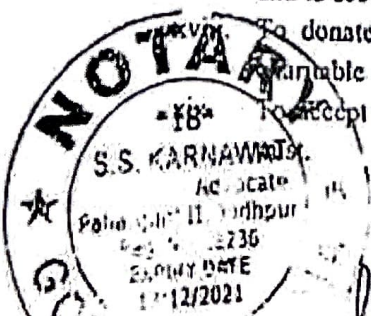
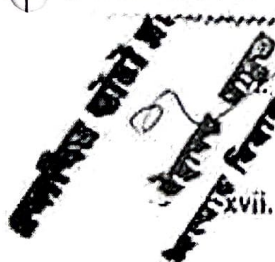
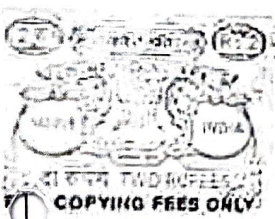
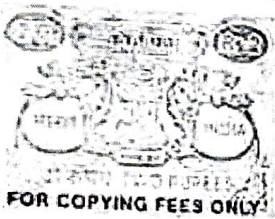
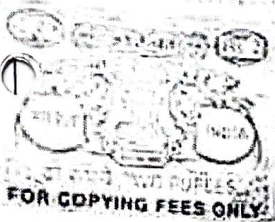
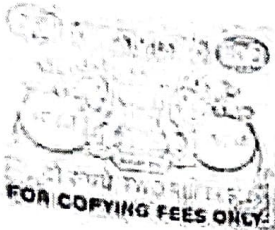
To publish papers, articles, educational books, periodicals and magazines and required, establish printing and composing facilities for such purposes.

To make such fixed deposit or other investment which may be necessary to obtain permission/sanction of universities or other Government bodies for the running of schools/colleges or other educational institutions etc.

To borrow money from any banks (Govt. and Private banks both) or private parties to finance the acquiring, establishing, maintaining, etc of educational institutions and equipments therein and to accept donations or contributions for the same purpose.

To donate money or other assets to other trust/society, societies, institutions etc. having similar objects/similar to the object/ of this trust.

To accept money or other assets as donation from others for the aforesaid objects/s of this

xx. In case of need, to transfer all the assets and liabilities of this trust to any other public charitable trust, public charitable society/societies, public charitable institutions having such charitable object/a as are similar to the object of this trust.

xxi. In case of need, to accept all the assets and liabilities for this trust from any other public charitable trust/a, public charitable society/societies, public charitable institutions having such charitable object/a as are similar to the objects of this trust.

xxii. In case of need, to work in association with any other public charitable trust/a public charitable society/societies, public charitable institutions having such charitable object/a as are similar to the objects of this trust and

xxiii. To do all acts, deeds or things incidental to or necessary for the fulfillment of the aforesaid objects.

It is clarified that none of the above subjects is intended for the benefit of any particular caste or community. No discrimination on basis of caste, colour, creed or sex will be tolerated by their absolute discretion and in any manner they deem fit. However, the Board of Trustees will be the super governing body, decisions of which will have to be followed by other supporting sub ordinate bodies. The rules, regulations, rights, duties, etc of such committee, sub ordinate boards/a, post/a, etc. will be enacted/provided once they come into existence.

f) In order to fulfill daily functions/duties and to meet objectives of the trust, the trustees will have the right to enact/append, amend or cancel rules/laws of the Trust.

g) The trustee shall be entitled to utilize the corpus of the trust fund for the purposes set out aforesaid at their absolute discretion, in such proportion and in such manner and on such terms and conditions as think fit.

h) Shri Atul Sankhla and Shri Vishal Bohra would primarily look after the day to day affairs of the trust. They would be responsible for the activities of the trust unless otherwise specified or implied.

1. MEETING

a) The trustee may meet together as and when they may think necessary. But they shall hold at least one meeting in a year.

(b) The quorum at a meeting of the trustee shall be of two, when the strength of the trustees is four. The quorum shall be three if the strength is more than four.

(c) The Chairman shall preside over all meetings of the trust. In case he is not present, the trustee present shall elect one of them as chairman of that meeting. The trustees shall act according to the decisions of the majority of the trustees. When the trustees are not unanimous, the chairman shall have the casting vote.

(d) There will be no need of a quorum for adjourned meeting wherein agenda of last meeting will be discussed and decided.

(e) A resolution passed by circulation by the majority of the trustees shall be valid and effective as a resolution passed at a meeting of trustees.

6. FINANCIAL YEAR : The financial year of the Trust shall commence from 1st April and shall close on 31st March of every year.

7. **BANK ACCOUNT** : The trustees shall open bank account or accounts in the name of the trust in any nationalised / reputed bank, which will be operated by signature of any of the trustees.

8. **ACCOUNT AND AUDITS** : The trustee shall maintain proper accounts, which will be annually audited by a chartered accountant appointed by any of the trustee fixing his remuneration.

9. **DISSOLUTION** : In unfortunate event of the aforesaid objects being incapable of carrying into effect, the trustees may divert the funds of the trust to any other appropriate charitable purpose and dissolve as per relevant rules of law and past cases or may act as per cypress doctrine.

10. TRUST PROPERTY :

The settler hereby vest finally and irrevocable a sum of Rs. 10,000/- as stated hereinabove in the trustees for and on behalf of the trust. This amount of Rs. 10,000/- constitutes initial fund of the trust. Any further sum/s received in the form of money or money's worth by way of income, donations, gifts, grants, etc. or required by any other mode by the trust, will also be the property of the trust. The property of the trust shall vest in the trustees only for and on behalf of the trust.

11. BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

The administration, management and control of the trust and its properties shall vest in the hands of a board/committee to be called the Board of Trustees.

(a) The first trustees of the trust who have accepted to be on the Board of Trustees shall be below (details about them have already been given hereinabove) :

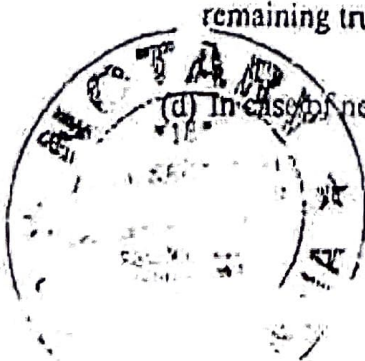

(b) The trustees shall hold office for whole of their lives unless any of them desires to be discharged of this duties or becomes mentally or physically incapable of working or is declared insolvent or is convicted of a criminal offence.

(c) In the event of a vacancy arising in the Board of Trustees for whatever reason/s the remaining trustees shall co-opt any person to fill up the vacancy.

(d) In case of need, the Board of Trustees may admit any person/s as trustee/s.

(e) Those trustee who will work for the day to day management of the activities of the trust like management of college/s, school/s, hospital/s, hostels, etc. to be owned and maintained by the trust, shall be paid such reasonable remuneration as will be decided by the Board of Trustees. Further, the trustees will be entitled for reimbursement of expenses incurred by them in the conduct of their duties or in promotion of the objects of the trust, on behalf of the trust. No trustee shall be entitled to take any advantage for himself or any member of his family in whatever from or manner from the trust.

(f) A trustee who by his conduct as a trustee or in his personal life, adversely reflects on the reputation of the trust, may be asked by the Board of Trustees by a resolution passed by a majority to submit his resignation failing which shall be cease to be trustee with effect from the date of passing of such resolution.

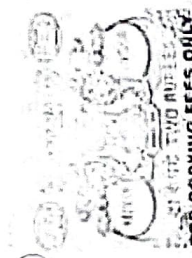
(g) The trustee may institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal proceeding by or against the trust or trustees.

(h) The trustee will have the right to put to use the asset/property of the trust, after consent from the board, in such a manner that they are productive and realize some net-worth or income to the trust.

(i) The trustees of the trust may obtain payment of money from all courts and departments of the State and Central Governments including local authority or authorities.

(j) The trustee shall be empowered to employ whole time or part time servants, clerks and professional and personal according to the requirement of the trust on such norms and conditions as they may decide from time to time. The trustees shall have power to accept honorary services of any person to do the work in the trust. The trustees shall have full disciplinary control and powers over such staff, employees, workers, etc. working honorary or otherwise.

(k) The trustees may constitute committees, sub-committees, sub-ordinate boards like board of management or executive and / or create institute-wise or department-wise or filed-wise post/s to facilitate control and management, effectively and efficiently.
